MHHS ACTIVATION VS MHHS QUALIFICATION ENERGY



Issue

- Provisions within the REC relating to Reverse Migration, reference MHHS Qualification i.e. where an MHHS
 Metering Point is registered by a Supplier that is not MHHS Qualified, then the Metering Point will undergo
 Reverse Migration.
- In practice, the qualification status does not determine whether a Metering Point should be Reverse Migrated.
 - After MHHS Qualification, each Supplier will undergo activation which includes agreement of their Migration Plan, onboarding to the DIP production environment and inclusion within Industry Standing Data (ISD). The ISD effective from date will determine the status of the Supplier and therefore whether a Metering Point is Reverse Migration by the SMRS.

Scope item approach

- REC provisions relating to MHHS Qualification are derived from Section C12 of the BSC, however the Balancing & Settlement Code (BSC) does not define activation and therefore the REC drafting cannot be updated to cross reference the BSC.
- REC drafting developed to introduce additional definitions to ensure the provisions legally reflect the technical solution
- Update migration drafting to reference new definitions
- Approach shared and supported by Programme drafting stakeholders

MHHS ACTIVATION VS MHHS QUALIFICATION ENERG



- New definitions:
 - **DIP Identifier**: means the unique identifier by which a Market Participant is identified when using the Data Integration Platform.
 - MHHS Activation: means, in respect of a Party, that such Party has been onboarded to the Data Integration
 Platform with a valid DIP Identifier effective within the Industry Standing Data. "MHHS Activated" and
 similar expressions shall be interpreted accordingly.
- No changes required by participants, no impact assessment required

 - Schedule 9 Qualification & Maintenance
