Headline Report and Actions	DECISION: The headline report of the previous meeting on 19 December 2024 was approved (QAG-DEC50 – recording timestamp 00:05:34).
Qualification Approach and Plan	<p>The Code Bodies presented the Qualification Approach and Plan (QA&P) v3.2 and Annexes 1 and 2 v2.2 to QAG for approval.</p> <p>DECISION: The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved the Qualification Approach and Plan v3.2 (QAG-DEC51 – recording timestamp 00:07:38).</p> <p>DECISION: The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved Annex 1 of the Non-SIT LDSO MHHS Qualification Approach and Plan v2.2 (QAG-DEC52 – recording timestamp 00:08:48).</p> <p>DECISION: The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved Annex 2 of the Non-SIT Supplier and Agent MHHS Qualification Approach and Plan v2.2 (QAG-DEC53 – recording timestamp 00:09:38).</p> <p>Will go on to collaboration base once published.</p>
Non-SIT LDSO QT Readiness	The Programme provided an update on Non-SIT LDSO QT.
DTN Update	<p>The Code Bodies sought feedback from industry on the use of DTN to support build and test activities.</p> <p>The Medium Supplier Representative queried if there were further updates but they had already completed some or all of their PIT, would they need to repeat updates on the newer version. The REC Representative confirmed that the expectation is that Suppliers complete PIT on the latest version of Market Design, looking at the Design documents rather than DTC to support PIT activity. However, if they have used the DTC and believe it will impact their timescales for completing PIT, the suggested having a conversation with REC to discuss the appropriate next steps.</p> <p>The Supplier Agent Representative (Independent) queried when the full list of discrepancies between the Design and DTC will be released. The REC Representative confirmed they are planning to update DTC by 10 February 2025 and would like to ensure they provide that information to PPs around the same time.</p> <p>ACTION – REC to publish a list of DTC and DTN updates required to address identified discrepancies and reflect MHHS Design IR8.7 (QAG13-01).</p>

Programme Milestones related to QAG	The Programme and Code Bodies provided an overview of the upcoming Programme Milestones related to QAG.
Top Programme Risks Related to QAG	<p>The Programme provided an update on the Top Programme Risks Related to QAG.</p> <p>The Large Supplier Representative queried when the 31 Core Tests in relation the Placing Reliance will be published and also raised concerns from Suppliers around R1021 and needing the Company Director to sign off the QAD. The Code Bodies confirmed the plan is to publish the Core Tests with QWG papers on 4 February 2025 and clarified that for the QAD sign off, a PDF letter can be downloaded and signed off physically by the Company Director, which can then be uploaded to the portal on their behalf.</p> <p>The Programme also added this will be added as a mitigating action into the RAID log.</p>
AOB	<p>The Large Supplier Representative queried what the process is around responding to feedback from the initial QAD and how this will be reviewed by the Code Bodies before submitting their final QAD. The Code Bodies confirmed they expect the QAD to be iterative and assumes back and forth correspondence with the PP.</p> <p>The Supplier Agent Representative (Independent) raised a query in relation to the Ofgem Direction consultation that is looking to put in extra reporting measures following CR055 and stated that they expected there to be more obligations on them to update BSC on how they are progressing. The Ofgem Representative confirmed they are going to publish a set of proposed directions for PPs to provide them with that type of information.</p> <p>The DNO Representative queried if for the draft submission of QAD, it is expected to be iterative or just for the final QAD. The Code Bodies explained they expect more iterations of the initial QAD than the final given it is the first submission and that the review window in the plan is intended to allow for iterations if required. The DNO Representative also asked if they are still waiting for feedback from Code Bodies, should they add a note into the draft that they're pending further information or attempt to answer based on the knowledge they have. The Code Bodies confirmed that either approach is acceptable considering they are in contact with the Code Bodies. They also noted that although there are submission close dates which PPs are expected to meet, if any aspects of the QAD aren't finalised in time, they will continue to work with PPs to an agreed date of when the information will be ready for and can look to reopen to make updates if necessary.</p>
Summary and Next Steps	<p>The Secretariat confirmed the actions captured in the meeting.</p> <p>No comments or questions raised from participants.</p>
