Decision 1: RF Change to 7 months from Settlement Day	MCAG-DEC84	The Chair, acting with the delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved Milestone T2-EL-0200 'Recommendation to change to RF 7 Months Calendar' applicable from the Settlement Date of 01 October 2026 onwards.	The Programme invited objections to the approval of Decision 1, to which none were received.

Key Discussion Items:

Decision 1: RF Change to 7 months from Settlement Day	The Programme presented the STEG recommendation to reduce RF from 14 months to seven months for Settlement Dates from 1 October 2026. They confirmed that both approved decision criteria have been met: the Settlement Performance Metric recorded a 0.07% delta, below the 1% threshold, and 63% of MPANs had completed Migration as of 28 August 2026, exceeding the 60%
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	threshold. STEG unanimously recommended that MCAG approve the change. The Programme noted that Migration Completion has increased further since the meeting papers were prepared, reaching 67% as of 114 September 2026. • The I&C Supplier Representative raised concerns from the non-domestic constituency that insufficient energy volume had migrated to provide confidence in the decision, noting that the settlement delta may not indicate future performance while only a limited proportion of energy volume is settled under MHHS. Concerns were also raised about CVA readiness, as reflected by the work on BSC Issue 122. The Programme confirmed that the agreed decision criteria had been met and process had been followed and noted that energy volume was not included in the criteria because Suppliers determine the order in which the MPANs in their portfolios migrate over to MHHS. The Programme agreed to raise a risk covering concerns about the level of migrated energy volume and continue monitoring the position as further non-domestic volume migrates. The Programme also noted that existing risks already capture CVA readiness concerns and the progress of Issue 122. They clarified that these concerns are more directly relevant to the later SF reduction decision, than the current decision to reduce RF to seven months. • The DNO Representative asked which constituency had raised the concerns. The I&C Supplier Representative confirmed that they had been raised by the non-domestic constituency. • The Chair queried when further non-domestic Migration would provide additional evidence. The Programme confirmed that I&C Suppliers are beginning to migrate during Sprint 4, with further activity expected to accelerate through Sprints 5 and 6. The Chair invited objections to the proposed decision, to which none were received. DECISION: The Chair, acting with the delegated authority of the MHHS SRO, approved Milestone T2-EL-0200 'Recommendation to change to RF 7 Months Calendar' applicable from the Settlement Date of 01 October 2026 onwards (MCAG-DEC84 – recording timestamp 14:13). The Programme confirmed that the decision will be communicated to interested parties. Elexon will produce the April 2027 Settlement Calendar incorporating the reduction in RF to seven months. • The Chair asked for further information on Elexon's next steps/plan for producing the revised Settlement Calendar. The Elexon Representative agreed to provide an update at the 22 September 2026 MCAG. ACTION: Elexon to provide an update on next steps/plan for producing the Settlement Calendar incorporating the reduction of RF to seven months (MCAG28.1-01).
